Cruise Itinerary

Thursday 17th April 2025

This morning we depart Staffordshire and travel to the port of Newcastle. We embark the beautiful Borealis our home for the next 8 nights.

Friday 18th April 2025 - At sea

A wonderful day to relax and explore the fabulous facilities on Borealis, our floating hotel.

Saturday 19th April 2025 - Cruising & Amsterdam, Netherlands

Early this morning sees us cruising the North Sea Canal. This is Amsterdam's direct link to the North Sea and is one of the country's busiest and most important shipping lanes. Along the banks of the 16 mile long canal, from the mouth at IJmuiden, to the end in Amsterdam, there is an abundance of interesting fortifications from World War II, as well as beautiful beaches and nature reserves. We arrive in Amsterdam later this morning. Historic Amsterdam is a network of waterways lined with elegant merchant homes, museums and friendly cafés. The iconic Canal Ring is best explored by glass-topped boat, passing significant monuments and seeing the city from a different perspective. The Anne Frank House, where Anne and her family hid from the Germans during the Second World War, is a poignant landmark in the heart of the city.

Sunday 20th April 2025 - At sea

At day at sea, enjoy some time relaxing on board, perhaps indulge in an afternoon tea.

Monday 21st April 2025 - Cruising

Today we start our scenic cruising by sailing past the diverse landscapes of Alderney, a haven for various species of flora and fauna, historical sites, aquamarine waters and unique island charm. We continue to cruise past the island of Sark, considered to be the crown jewel of the Channel Islands and nestled between Guernsey and Jersey. This afternoon we cruise by Brecqhou, a tiny island west of Sark, before sailing past the headlands of Pleinmont and Jerbourg on Guernsey.

Tuesday 22nd April 2025 - St. Mary's, Isles of Scilly

Today we arrive in St. Mary's, the largest of the five inhabited islands that make up the Isles of Scilly archipelago. The island offers a fascinating heritage, where traces of life go back at least eight centuries. The entire archipelago is a designated area of Outstanding Natural Beauty and a Marine Conservation Zone, where there is an abundance of marine life and migrant birds, such as gannets and even puffins as well as Atlantic grey seals.

Wednesday 23rd April 2025 - Honfleur, France

We arrive in Honfleur this morning, a medieval town with great maritime history and the opportunity to stroll charming 16th century streets, see eye-catching architecture and visit it's colourful old harbour (Vieux Bassin). The extraordinary light in Honfleur has attracted artists for many years, with masterpieces housed in it's museums and art galleries. Under the guidance of Eugene Boudin, a young Claude Monet and his friend Alfred Sisley began studying light effects and painting landscapes outdoors, rather than from memory, trailblazing for artists of the future.

Thursday 24th April 2025 - At sea

Enjoy a leisurely day of cruising today, with exceptional on board hospitality as we sail home.

Friday 25th April 2025

Arriving back to Newcastle early morning, we transfer back to Staffordshire.
