Tour Itinerary

Sunday 26th June 2022

Travel North towards Northumberland with stop en-route to experience the beautiful Durham Cathedral, with free time to further explore Durham. We arrive at the Hog's Head Inn Hotel our home for the next 4 nights, in time to settle before dinner. (D)

Monday 27th June 2022

This morning we visit nearby Alnwick Castle taking in a guided tour, this remarkable residence is steeped in history and has been home to the Duke of Northumberland's family for over 700 years. Time for lunch (at own expense), before our guided tour of Alnwick Gardens with free time to either take in their glorious surroundings or stroll around the market town of Alnwick. (B,D)

Tuesday 28th June 2022

Today we travel to National Trust Cragside, an extraordinary Victorian house with a rich décor from the arts and craft period. Wander amongst the cascading rock gardens, tumbling waterfalls and meander around the wonderful woodland. The world's first house to be lit by hydroelectricity and powered by hydraulics, classed as Britain's original smart home. Feel free to enjoy a spot of lunch in the tea rooms (at own expense). (B,D)

Wednesday 29th June 2022

We journey to the famous Holy Island of Lindisfarne. Explore the island village, have the opportunity to visit the historic Priory established in the 7th century or the famous Castle which was converted by architect Sir Edwin Lutyens into a private holiday home (at own expense). Why not call into the winery and sample their Lindisfarne Mead a unique fortified wine! The afternoon takes us to the historic Bamburgh Castle, where there are 2000 artefacts in this dramatic ancient site, perched high above the town, beach and sea with views out across the Farne Islands. Thursday 30th June 2022

This morning we say goodbye to our hotel and head to the fantastic open-air museum of Beamish, and experience a taste of history from the Victorian era to Second World War. Following a wonderful day, we begin our return journey home to Cheshire. (B)
