# **Tour Itinerary**

**Sunday 8th September 2024** 

Depart Staffordshire this morning, we journey to the medieval market town of Ludlow. Explore the historic town centre with an abundance of architectural gems and the 11th century Castle which are situated on a cliff above the River Teme and are surrounded by the beautiful countryside of south Shropshire. Continue to our home for 4 nights, the Gwbert Hotel. (D)

Monday 9th September 2024

After breakfast we travel to the seaside town of Tenby, known for its 13th century town walls and its stretches of sandy shoreline, including Castle Beach. Discover the ruins of Tenby Castle on the headland overlooking the harbour aligned with colourful buildings. Take a stroll round the Museum and Art Gallery housing a 16th century wrought-iron cannon. Arriving back at our hotel for a leisurely afternoon. (B,D)

**Tuesday 10th September 2024** 

We head to the Pembrokeshire Coast for a guided coach tour with our Blue Badge Guide. The Coastline offers a gateway to a range of stunning landscapes, backed by hills, estuaries, valleys and woodlands that allows you to discover something different throughout the journey. Early afternoon we arrive in St Davids, the smallest city in Britain and has been a place of pilgrimage for centuries. Embark on a self-guided tour of the 12th century Cathedral, constructed from dusky purple sandstone and sits tucked away in a sheltered vale beside the River Alun. Visit the impressive Treasury collection and enjoy home-cooked food at The Refectory (at own expense) before heading back to our hotel in time to freshen up before dinner. (B,D)

Wednesday 11th September 2024

Today we journey to the National Botanic Garden of Wales. Set in over 500 acres, explore the spectacular dome which is the largest single-span glasshouse in the world, resembling a giant raindrop. It houses some of the most endangered plants from around the world, that thrive in rocky terraces, sandstone cliffs and gravelled scree slopes. Wander around the parkland, the Waun Las Nature Reserve or the magical, deep, dark woods with amazing hand-crafted cravings on the Gruffalo trail. Mid afternoon sees us in Carmarthen with a rich and colourful history. Take a wander around the Castle which sits proudly above the River Tywi or the independent shops and market. (B,D)

Thursday 12th September 2024

After breakfast, our journey home will take us through the beautiful Welsh countryside. We will stop along with free time to explore and lunch (at own expense). Mid afternoon we depart and make our way back to Staffordshire, arriving late afternoon with memories of a wonderful tour. (B)
